Applications are due by Monday Week 7 of Term 3 or Term 1.

### **Colours Application Process**

- 1. Applicant submits completed Colours Application Form from the website via email to College Services by the deadline
- 2. Applicant interviewed by relevant Co-Curricular staff [at the discretion of the school]
- 3. All applications for that period considered by the Awards Committee
- 4. Applicant informed in writing of outcome of the decision

Please complete separate applications if applying for more than one co-curricular area.

- Is likely to have received Tabs in activities within the co-curricular area for which they are applying.


#### [Sport only]

The Awards Committee reserves the right to withdraw Colours from a student should their conduct or commitment within that co-curricular area fall below the standards expected of a Colours recipient.






